#### INTRODUCTION:

#### PRAYER POINTS

2. O Lord, give them a renewed favor and fresh anointing to prosper at home, work, and in this church in Jesus' name - Ps. 92:10; 102:13.
3. Father, cause their land of settlement to produce milk and honey for them in abundance in Jesus' name. Where they have planted, may they reap bountiful harvests, even enjoying harvest where they have not labored.
4. Lead them to fertile grounds O Lord, that they may sow and reap Your blessings continually as Isaac did in a foreign land - Genesis 26:12-14.
5. Many of them may have to work many hours. Despite this, according to Psalm 92:13-14, may they be firmly planted in your house and flourish in your courts in Jesus' name. May they continue to bear fruits in old age and stay fresh and green.
6. Father, satisfy their personal and family needs, that they may have sufficient to give for the expansion of the kingdom of God and support of the church.
7. Favor them before Kings and princes; mercifully grant them their hearts' desires in line with the will and purpose of God.
8. May their faith in Christ not be deterred by the vices of the world that are prevalent and normalized in the Western world.

9. May all enemies of the Gospel in their lives and environment be subdued in the might name of Jesus - 1 Corinthians 16:9.

10. May their lifestyle and passions ignite the hearts of those around them to the ways of the Lord. May their lives be a testimony for the kingdom of God, in Jesus' name.
